Significant Alarms

Water Rescue

On January 13, North Battalion units responded to a water rescue on Ebey Island with units from SCFD #4 and Everett Fire Department. Crews found an overturned vehicle in a slough on Ebey Island. E82 provided scene lighting and extrication tools. Firefighter Rescue swimmers helped the patient from the vehicle. The patient was evaluated and treated by SCFD #4 personnel.

Motor Vehicle Collison with Entrapment

On January 16, East Battalion and SCFD #4 units responded to a report of a high-speed motor vehicle collision with one person entrapped. Crews arrived and found one entrapped patient, and two patients that were conscious and alert. The crews had a difficult time extricating the driver, and the driver was transported, code, to Providence Everett. The other two patients were transported to Evergreen Monroe for further assessment.

Probationary Firefighter Training Program

The Training Division has made changes to the Probationary Firefighter Book, the training evaluations, and the crew responsibilities as they relate to the success of our probationary firefighters. Lt. Hammeren presented the new Probationary Training Program at the Leadership Meeting, and it was well received. Lt. Hammeren and Lt. Karapostoles also made an informative video with the help of Adam Perron addressing these changes to the probation book and to the probationary training evaluation.
