They first established what a Battalion, Suburban and Rural station would look like. That information was sent to Operations. That team looked at the list and prioritized based on operational needs. Then the Architectural team looked at the structural, mechanical and electrical engineer reports and prioritized. The Facility Planning group came back together and came up with this all-inclusive list. The objective now is to allow the BOC to review the list and give recommendations on moving forward. Commissioner Gagnon brought up a potential training facility for our district. The Board of Commissioners expressed appreciation for the comprehensive process and detailed report presented.
