Determination of NonSignificance

Name of Proposed Action: Snohomish Regional Fire and Rescue Station 32

Description of Proposal: Snohomish Regional Fire and Rescue (SRFR) is issuing this Determination of NonSignificance (DNS) letter for the attached State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) documentation for the proposed SRFR Station 32 which would support the present and future demands of emergency services and public safety for the community.

The proposed action would include the construction of a new, single-story building for the Snohomish Regional Fire & Rescue Fire Station 32 (11,500 SF) and associated access, parking areas, and landscaping on a 2.16-Acre lot. Subsurface disturbance would include 1500 cubic yards of imported fill, and is limited to installation of foundations, utilities, associated stormwater management requirements, fencing, and other security features.
